Where possible the movement of any equipment will be carried out by the crew who has received moving and handling training. Ensure assistance is sought if there is any doubt about moving equipment and to assist with doors, steps, ramps and busy traffic routes. Ensure lifting aids are available (trollets, barrows) arre used Ensure when equipment is positioned in trolleys, wheels are locked. Ensure that loads are stable before moving. The movement of equipment and furniture should be planned so that corridors and staircases are busy. Ensure objects can be held correctly, if gloves are required to improve grip, they should be made available. Multiple stage and fixture checks have been completed to ensure that it is well-built.
